



Vinos Tintos - Red Wines

- Bodegas Rico, 'Carchelo', Monastrell/Syrah/Merlot, Jumilla, Spain** \$29.00
Jumilla native Agapito Rico started this progressive winery in 1983 using a collection of old family vineyards, focused mainly on the native grape Monastrell (Mourvedre). This juicy blend offers a nose of leather, earth and dark but healthy plum and blackberry. The wine shows balance via bright acidity and firm tannins. It finishes with a fat, spicy finish.
- Tapeña Garnacha, Tierra de Castilla, Spain** \$26.00
Garnacha is the most widely planted red wine grape in Spain. In the mouth, there is a rush of dark fruit with an underlying bright spice. Including hints of rosemary. Is full-bodied, but still lively, with rounded tannins which combine with fruit to produce a velvety finish.
- Abadía Retuerta, Rívola, Sardón de Duero, Spain** \$36.00
Violet, black cherry, pepper and tabaco on nose. On the palate, plum and black currants with firm tannins and balance acidity
- Pazo de Arribi, Mencia, Bierzo Spain** \$38.00
Made from old vine "Mencia" which is an ancestor of the Cabernet Franc grape. Full-bodied and ripe and smooth in character, balance by a deft touch of oak from three months aging in barriques..
- Bodegas Palacio, Glorioso Reserva, Rioja, Spain** \$35.00
Made from 100% Tempranillo, this is a medium-bodied wine with aromas of licorice and marmalade, vanilla and coffee. It is elegant and fleshy with a long, balanced finish and soft tannins
- Miguel Torres Coronas, Catalunya, Spain** \$32.00
Made with 86% Tempranillo and 14% Cabernet Sauvignon. Intense colour, with expressive aromas reminiscent of plum with a vanilla black ground from ageing
- Marques de Caceres, Reserva, Rioja, Spain** \$48.00
Produced from old vine Tempranillo, Graciano and Mazuelo grapes, it is elegant, medium-full bodied with textured forward fruit and a layered, memorable aftertaste.
- Bodegas Bretón, Reserva, Rioja, Spain** \$42.00
Breton's mature low-yielding estate vineyards give fruit with concentrated extract and acidity. Aged 19 months in oak and a further 12 in bottle prior to release, developing silkiness with bottle age. Bouquet of ripe fruit is well integrated with toasty balsamic notes
- Bodegas Alejandro Fernández, Tinto Pesquera, Ribera del Duero** \$68.00
Produced from old vine Tempranillo, Graciano and Mazuelo grapes, it is elegant, medium-full bodied with textured forward fruit and a layered, memorable aftertaste.
- Abadía Retuerta, Couée Palomar, Sardón de Duero, Spain** \$92.00
This dense wine shows ripe blackberry and cherry aromas; on the palate, black fruits, cedar and pepper carry through to a rich, lasting finish. 50% Tempranillo & 50% Cabernet Sauvignon

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- Trinchero, Cabernet Sauvignon, Lake County, California** \$29.00
A delicious easy drinking Cabernet, hailing from the Trinchero family's estate vineyards in the rural county bordering Napa, Sonoma and Mendocino. It is deep, dense and ripe with flavors of plums, dried herbs and red earth
- St. Supery, Meritage, Napa, California** \$72.00
St. Supery is known for making rich, complex, yet approachable Napa Valley wines. Their top wine is a Bordeaux style blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. The nose exhibits red plum, current, dill, coffee, and toasty oak followed by deep dense rich flavors of wild berry, cassis, chocolate, herb, red & black plum in the mouth with a long and elegant finish. Fresh, yet very masculine and nice balanced.
- Viña Siegel, Crucero Carmenere, Colchagua Valley, Chile** \$26.00
The deep ruby color, with aromas of red berries and spices, well balanced with complexity thanks to aging in French oak barrels. The Palate is Elegant, with silky tannins and a big lingering finish.
- Lagar de Bezana, Aguacero, Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon, Alto Cachapoal Valley ...** \$34.00
This stunning wine may be your taste of the surprising and delicious Carmenere, a classic Bordeaux varietal thought extinct for 100 years and recently rediscovered in the pure unspoiled Anden foothills
- Viña Siegel, El Crucero Cabernet Sauvignon, Colchagua Valley, Chile** \$39.00
Chocolate and themes of red fruit, plums and jam, with hints of black pepper. Joyfully juicy, good structure with firm tannins, and a long, enjoyable finish.
- Casa Lapostole, Cuvee Alexandre Merlot, Rapel Valley, Chile** \$49.00
This is the reserve Merlot from this top winery. A fleshy wine exhibiting great dept, complexity & finesse with a beam of raspberry & blackberry fruit, as well as ample dark chocolate, hints of dried herbs & toast. A well-built Merlot that's ripe and modern with an admirable long finish.
- Errazuriz, Max Reserva Shiraz, Aconcagua Valley, Chile** \$37.00
The wine exhibits big ripe flavors of red and black fruit with integrated vanilla and toast from the barrel ageing. The wine is well structured with supple tannins that create a velvety mouthfeel
- Terrazas, Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina** \$28.00
This wine is made from specially selected vineyard sites, 3,000 feet above sea level in the terraces of the Andes. It is rich and juicy with aromas of red, black and dried fruits especially plums and figs. Further hints of vanilla and caramel combine with soft, well-ripened tannin on the finish.
- Luigi Bosca, Pinot Noir Reserva, Mendoza, Argentina** \$36.00
Superb new world style Pinot Noir from this highly respected Argentinean winery. The flavors are fresh and fruit driven, with cherry, strawberry and sweet baking spices dominating. It is a light to medium bodied wine with an elegant soft finish.

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Vinos Espumantes- Sparkling Wines

- Segura Viudas Cava, Aria Brut NV, Penedes, Spain** \$29.00
 Estate produced Methode champenoise sparkler. It is dry and lively with flavors of almond, pineapple, honey & hints of pear and Brioche bread.
- Domaine Chandon, Brut NV, Sonoma, California** \$48.00
 The California property of renowned Champagne house Moet et Chandon. This is a delicious fresh and fruit forward style
- Moet et Chandon, White Star Brut NV, Epernay, France** \$65.00
 Classic medium bodied champagne with excellent depth of flavor showing citrus fruits, biscuit, and sourdough bread notes

Vinos Blancos- White Wines

- Casa Lapostolle, Sauvignon Blanc, Rapel Valley, Chile** \$31.00
 This winery continues to be one of the most highly regarded in Chile, featured yet again on Wine Spectators top 100 wines from 2004. A Light and refreshing wine, but not lacking in dept. Flavors of melon, grapefruit and lime/lemon notes are predominant. It is so crisp and delicious.
- Viña Siegel, Crucero, Sauvignon Blanc, Colchagua Valley, Chile.** \$26.00
 Zesty grapefruit, aromas of fresh grass and an elegant tangerine finish make this wine a terrific summer treat! Fruity and fresh! Pair with salads, scallops or by itself. Delicious with Ceviche
- Adegas Morgadio, Albarino, Rias Baixas, Spain** \$40.00
 Another family owned, small production, estate bottled wine from North Western Spain. 100% Albarino made in a fuller-bodied style with generous flavors of almond, pear, lemon and distinct mineral notes. This white has the structure to match well with bigger dishes, but remains crisp and refreshing.
- Bodegas Angel Rodriguez, Martinsancho-Verdejo, Rueda, Spain** \$36.00
 A beautiful boutique estate wine, made from 17th. century old vine Verdejo cuttings from the famous Martinsancho vineyard. The wine is rich and creamy with typical melon/peach/ mineral flavors that linger on the long finish. A balanced, memorable wine.
- Huguet de Can Feixes, Blanco Seleccion, Penedes, Spain** \$32.00
 Can Feixes is a historic mountain side estate founded in 1768. The wine is a fragrant, firm and mineral dry white. It consists of a blend of traditional grapes; Parellada, Macabeo and touch of Chardonnay which offers a complex, yet delectable wine.
- Bodegas Breton, Lorinon Blanco, Barrel Fermented, Rioja Alta, Spain** \$36.00
 Intense aromas of black fruit-berries, cassis, dried fruit, black cherries and wood notes.
- Concha y Toro, Casillero del Diablo, Chardonnay, Casablanca Valley, Chile** \$26.00
 The name translates to Cellar of the Devil. A Legend invented by the founder that the Devil inhabited his cellar. It was made up to keep strangers away from his private collection. This is a fresh, yet intense wine exhibiting flavors of pineapple, citrus and green apple with a vanilla backdrop..
- Viña Siegel, El Crucero, Chardonnay Reserva, Colchagua Valley, Chile** \$38.00
 This rich wine is partly fermented in French oak barrels at low temperatures to extract maximum flavors from the top quality grapes. Concentrated buttery and honey nose, attractive fruit on the palate well balanced with oak.
- Viña Casanueva, Cava Submarinas Chardonnay-Muscat, Itata Valley, Chile** \$34.00
 Underwater Cellar. This wine glows with a soft pear, accompanied with floral note. In the mouth it is broad, with a good level of fresh fruit and with a pleasant mineral aroma, round and clean.

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
